SHOWMANSHIP

Showmanship Classes will be divided by # of Entries.

Please put date of birth on entry form. Showmanship will begin at 8am Saturday and 8:30am Sunday.

Age as of January 1st of the Show Year

A registration or recordation certificate is required for all animals six months of age or older and may be required for animals under six months of age if the show so chooses. A registration or recordation certificate or a stamped duplicate application showing the date received by the ADGA office is required for all animals under six months of age. Show officials shall not accept copies of the aforesaid, any other document in lieu of them, or information obtained from the ADGA office via telephone, etc. A stamped duplicate is valid for 30 days from the ADGA office date stamped on it.

Awards provided for; breed winners, Best Junior Doe in Show, Best Senior Doe in show, Best Buck in show and Best Jr. Doe and Sr. Doe Exhibited By a Youth in Ring 1 and 3, Showmanship, and numerous other youth awards. All rings are separately sanctioned for Alpines, LaManchas, Nubian, Rec. Grades, Nigerian Dwarfs, Oberhasli, AOP (Toggenburg, Saanen & Sable) ADGA breeds. No pre-show milk out. Bucks are separately sanctioned for Alpine, Nubian, Nigerians Dwarf & All other Purebreds.
